<p><u>for ANY "low/limited income" pet owner/guardian</u> (disabled, unemployed, receiving assistance, etc.) these organizations make modest payments to participating community veterinarians in your name thereby reducing your cost to fix your dog or cat. Call AFTER you make appt. – or - they can recommend a vet in your area if needed.</p>	<p>(One exception – Moreno Valley Clinic does not use these programs.)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Actors & Others, 818-755-6045, Mon-Fri, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.; if get a busy signal, hang-up & redial quickly to get through. Say you're calling for financial help to fix your pet(s); & you're NOT getting a voucher because Riverside County has no voucher program; & you got the referral info through POPCO's website 2. Pet Assistance Foundation, 877-772-9738. When recording starts, dial 1# to stop it, and then clearly state your name, phone #, and <u>repeat</u> your phone #. A Volunteer will call you back. (Pledging is limited to 6 vets/clinics.)
